- 1. Welcomes and apologies
- 2. Halloween review:

- 3. Treasurer's report : Despite the Halloween disco being a free event the donation covered costs with a surplus of £120. We have received a donation of £300 from Asda. Currently the PTA has approx £1100 in the bank.
- 4. Christmas pop up shop: to be held on Dec 12th. Donations can start being collected from the 9th Dec and boxes will be placed in the school foyer. There will be access to school to set up on the 9th from 245pm.
