The support can be delivered in a community setting, online or by telephone. The strategies and advice are evidenced and researched based and designed to support and build your confidence as a parent, promoting positive relationships with your children.

Can we help you?

We support parents of children up to age 12 (Primary 7) through:

- Bespoke one-to-one intervention in person or online.
- Group work – small groups delivered over six weeks in person and online.
- Short interactive discussion sessions on common parenting challenges.
- All our group workshops are delivered daytime and early evening throughout the school academic year.
